Find a Female Lawyer directory launched by Women Lawyers' Association of SA

The Women Lawyers' Association of South Australia's (WLASA) [Find a Female Lawyer](#) directory will be launched today by the Hon. Chris Kourakis, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of South Australia.

[Find a Female Lawyer](#) is an easy-to-use directory of Women Lawyers in South Australia. It lists female lawyers practising in South Australia in a searchable database. It is searchable by name, area of practice and geographic area. Information about each lawyer includes a link to their personal biography and whether they can be contacted to be a speaker.

It is the first directory designed specifically for finding female lawyers in Australia!

WLASA hopes that this directory will be a useful tool to assist women to promote themselves in the competitive legal market, as well as helping clients who want to find a female lawyer. There are many reasons clients may seek a female lawyer, from reaching their businesses' own gender equity targets to those with personal experiences of domestic violence or sex-discrimination.

Speakers at the launch will include a sole practitioner and Partner of a large corporate firm who will talk about the benefit of this service to female lawyers in their fields.

The launch will be attended by female lawyers listed on the site, women leaders from across various industry "Women-in" organisations, senior members of the Judiciary, and others.
