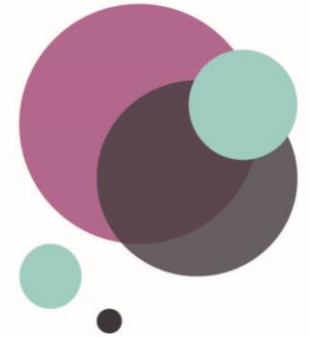

The Women Lawyers' Association of SA Inc (WLASA) is the South Australian branch of Australian Women Lawyers (AWL).

WLASA is led by a volunteer committee which represents all sectors of the legal profession. The association was formed in 1998 by the members of the Women Lawyers Committee of the Law Society of South Australia and its committee also continues to function in that role at well.

Our members come from all sectors of the legal profession – private practice, public sector, universities, judiciary, courts, law students and women not currently practising. Our members also include South Australian law firms and organisations that employ lawyers.

Our Objectives

WLASA was founded with a number of objectives in mind. These objectives include:

- To achieve justice and equality for all women
- To further the understanding and support of the legal rights of women
- To identify, highlight and eradicate discrimination against women inherent in the legal system and the community in general
- To advance equality for women in the legal profession
- To increase awareness of the contribution that women make to the practice and development of the law
- To make recommendations and submissions on law reform
- To provide a professional and social network for women lawyers

What we do

- Host regular professional and social networking events for women with a legal background or those in the legal profession
- Host CPD seminars, career seminars and information sessions for solicitors and law students
- Consult with the Chief of Justice of the Supreme Court and State Attorney General on the appointment of senior counsel and judiciary in South Australia
- Make submissions on proposed law reform, which are relevant to women and impact upon the broader justice arena
- Raise funds for charities which support disadvantaged women in our local and global communities
- Sponsor academic prizes in antidiscrimination and human rights law subjects

In 2013 WLASA co-hosted the Inaugural Margaret Nyland AM Long Lunch. Margaret Nyland AM, a former SA Supreme Court Justice, has been our Patron since 2000 and this event is held in her honor. This event is held yearly and attendance is not restricted to members of the legal profession.
